Section 1: Statutory Mandate Summary

Under the Data (Use and Access) Act 2025 (DUAA), which came fully into force on 19 June 2026, all UK organisations must maintain a formal data protection complaints handling process. The Act requires that all complaints from the public regarding data privacy must be formally acknowledged within 30 calendar days and investigated without undue delay. Fines for non-compliance reach up to £17.5M or 4% of global turnover. The UK Compliance Register provides the statutory hosted portal and logging audit trail to satisfy these requirements.

1. PURPOSE & STATUTORY ALIGNMENT

This statutory policy outlines our formal procedure for the intake, audit-logging, and resolution of data protection complaints under Section 30 of the Data (Use and Access) Act 2025 (DUAA). It applies to all processing of personal data within the UK.

2. COMPLAINT SUBMISSION CHANNELS

Complaints regarding data processing, privacy breaches, or subject rights can be submitted securely via our official portal node listed on the UK Compliance Register.

3. ACKNOWLEDGEMENT SLA MANDATE

In accordance with statutory timelines, all complaints will be formally acknowledged within 30 calendar days of receipt. A cryptographically hashed receipt and countdown SLA timeline will be generated for the complainant.

4. INVESTIGATION & DATA COMPLIANCE DEFICIT AUDITING

Complaints are automatically logged and routed to our designated compliance officer. We will investigate the details, assess potential data handling deficits, and determine corrective actions without undue delay.

5. RESOLUTION SLA OUTCOME

A formal resolution report detailing the final outcome and action logs will be dispatched directly to the complainant.

6. IMMUTABLE AUDIT TRAIL LEDGER

An immutable log of all cases, timestamps, and SLA compliance metrics is maintained on the public register for inspection by the Information Commissioner's Office (ICO) and corporate vendor auditors.

Section 3: Auditable Complaints Log & SLA Record

This registry logs all data protection complaints submitted via the company's public verification node. The Information Commissioner's Office (ICO) requires this log to prove compliance with statutory SLAs.
